Dear Parents and carers,

We have all felt like proud parents at Banwell this week! Our Reception class are now looking after the 10 chicks that have hatched from their eggs in our incubator. The children have been so excited waiting for them to hatch and it has been a delight to hear them talking all about the process.

We always strive to be the very best that we can be for our children and parents. We do however understand that sometimes issues arise that means children and / or parents are not happy. Please could I urge parents to contact school if they are unhappy about something. We will always endeavour to put things right but can only do this if we are informed.

We just want to take the opportunity to clarify the situation regarding supervision of the playground in the mornings before school. Mrs Lester and myself are always out in the playground at 8.40am at which time children can begin arriving in school. We stand by the gates which are adjacent to the school drive. Mrs Gould or Mrs Philpott are usually by the path which leads to the Littlefield's gate. There may be occasions when they are not at this gate however as they may need to deal with a class related issue. Please could we work together to remind the children that once they have arrived in school they must not go back outside of the playground.

#### Finally, a few reminders:

- Children should all be in school by 8.50 am. If on the rare occasion they are a little late please ensure that they are brought to the office so that they can be signed in.
- Please remember to keep your contact details up to date. It is so important that we are able to get
  hold of parents at all times but have sometimes found this difficult recently due to phone numbers
  not being accurate.
- Thank you to the vast majority of parents who collect their children promptly at 3.15pm the end of the school day. Unfortunately we do have a very small number of children who are frequently not collected on time and can often be left for long periods of time not collected. Not only does this distress the child but there is also no one available to supervise at this time. Please be reminded that children can be booked into Playpals up until 12 noon on the same day if childcare after school is going to be a problem. However if the same children are persistently collected late at the end of the school day we will have no option other than to send them to Playpals and the cost charged to the parent.
- We are finding a large number of lunchboxes are being left at the end of the day. Please ensure that if your child brings a lunchbox to school that they bring it home too!
