Dear Parents and carers,

I am hoping by now that your children may have told you all about our rebranded Golden Time in school! To clarify, 20 minutes of Golden Time is given on a Friday as a reward for making good behaviour choices throughout the week. Where choices have not been good children can lose minutes from this special time.

As a team we constantly reflect on what we are doing to ensure that it is the very best for our children. We had noticed that we had an increasing number of children in Key Stage 2 losing some of their Golden Time. As we strive for all children to show the expected high standard of behaviour we decided that we needed to do Golden Time a bit differently. From term 2 the children have had the opportunity to select a Golden Time club that they would like to attend up until Christmas.

We have established the following 8 Golden time clubs for them to choose from:
