Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to the new term. Please find attached an overview of the learning planned for Term 3 within our project of "What is a Toy's Story?"

We will begin our project with the story, 'Traction Man' by Mini Grey. We will be exploring the adventures he has in the story and also be making our own. Reading for pleasure is so important so choosing a familiar book they enjoy is just as valuable in developing reading skills. Please continue to write in their reading record. We will change your child's reading book on Mondays and Thursdays when it has been recorded in their reading record that they have read at least three times. If you would like to hear readers in school, your support would be greatly appreciated.

At the beginning of the year, homework will generally consist of reading and phonics and spelling games to help reinforce your child's learning. As we progress through the year, more activities may be added.
