During our time at the camp the children will have an opportunity to experience new things and build their confidence through team activities.

We will focussing on our core values -

On the Morning

- The children will need to arrive at school to be registered between 8:40 am and 8:50am in the Old hall.
- Parents are asked to sign in any medicines with Mrs Lester on the morning.
- Parents are welcome to stay outside at the front of the school to wave off the children when we leave at 9:15am.

Things to Pack

- Torch
- Toothbrush
- Warm Clothes (day and night)
- Clothes to cover legs (some activities in longer grass)
- Sleeping Bag + pillow
- Roll mat or suitable other (no lilo's please)
- Waterproofs (anorak or waterproof coat, waterproof trousers,)
- Sun cream and sun hat
- Plate, bowl, knife, fork, spoon, cup for hot chocolate, tea towel
- Appropriate footwear for physical activity (to include field walking)

- Wellies (can wear these on the day to save space)
- 1 spare pair trainers or other suitable footwear
- Teddy bear (if needed)
- Extra socks and undies.
- Warm hat for evening time
- Coat
- Sun hat and sun cream
- Carrier bag for dirty clothes
- Packed lunch for day 1 with refillable water bottle

(Children entitled to Free School Meals will be provided with one via the school but we do appreciate you may prefer to pack one yourself on this special occasion).

There is limited space on the coach so please pack everything in one back pack. An award will be given for the best packed person!

What we will be doing

Activities to include the following:

- Safety briefing & boundary walk
- Wide games/adventure course Free playtime
- Farmyard trail and nature walk Team games and challenges
- Water games
 Group meal cooked in the outdoors
- Talent show (children to prepare acts)
- Stories/songs around the fire. Hot drinks/fire snacks
- Sleeping under the stars (well in a tent!)

Sleeping arrangements

- There will be two large girls tents and two large boys tents for each class so 8 children's tents in total.
- We will sort who is in each tent when we get there.
- The children will be provided with a midnight feast so there is no need for them to bring any!

Food and drinks

- On the first day children will need a packed lunch which we will eat together around the camp fire.
- An evening meal is prepared on the camp fire and eaten together.
- Breakfast again is prepared around the camp fire.
- Fruit is available throughout both days.
- Hot chocolate and marshmallows before bed.
- Midnight feast will be provided.

Essential information forms and medicines

It is really important that we have the most up to date medical and emergency contact information for your child.

<u>Please ensure that you fill out the essential</u> information form and return it to the office.

If your child requires medicine whilst we are there you will need to complete a medicine form and sign in your medicine and form with Mrs Lester on the morning of the camp.

- We will arrive back at the school at approximately 11am- all children will be provided with a school dinner.
- On Friday afternoon please collect children and then belongings from the sports hall.
