FREE SCHOOL MEALS

North Somerset Council has replaced the old free school meal paper application forms with a new online checker. You will be able to apply online at home and get an instant result. The system will generate a letter that you can print off and give to the office to show eligibility.

You will need to reapply every school holiday (6 times per year) and eligibility will last for the whole school term. Each child in your family will need to be checked individually as the online checker creates a system code for each child.
