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## 1. Scope

This addendum applies until further notice.

Unless covered in this addendum, our normal behaviour policy continues to apply.

We may need to amend or add to this addendum as circumstances or official guidance changes. We will communicate any changes to staff, parents and pupils.

## 2. Expectations for pupils in school

### 2.1 New rules

When pupils are in school, we expect them to follow all of the rules set out below to keep themselves and the rest of the school community safe.

Staff will be familiar with these rules and make sure they are followed consistently.

Parents should also read the rules and ensure that their children follow the new procedures that have been put in place. Parents should contact Claire Pocock, Headteacher, if they think their child might not be able to comply with some or all of the rules, so we can consider alternative arrangements with them.

- All children must adhere to the new guidelines for arriving at and departing from school. This includes timings and socially distanced queuing.
- All children to follow guidance with regards to regular handwashing.
- **Children to stay in designated pods and not go into any other pods or rooms.**
- Children to adhere to one way systems as clearly marked out around school.
- Children to stay away from areas that are clearly marked as being out of bounds.
- Sneezes and coughs to ideally be caught in tissues and disposed in bins. Children to be familiar with 'catch it, bin it, kill it'
- Children to avoid touching their mouth, nose and eyes with hands
- Children to tell an adult if they feel unwell.
- Children to avoid sharing equipment and use own equipment, as provided.
- Children to adhere to amended break and lunchtimes.
- Children to only use the designated toilets for their pods.
- Children must not cough or spit at or towards any other person.
- Children must adhere to instructions from the adults in school at all times.

### 2.2 Rewards and sanctions for following rules

We will continue to do this in line with our current behaviour policy. Where there is a deliberate and serious breach of rules above school will consider an exclusion for the child.

## 3. Monitoring arrangements

We will review this policy as guidance from the local authority or Department for Education is updated. This addendum will be shared with the full governing body.
