

Mrs Jo Browett is reluctantly having to leave us in the summer due to personal circumstances. She is very much wanting to return to teaching in the future and is hoping this could even be a return to Banwell. We hope so too!

After 7 years at Banwell, where she started her teaching career, Miss Kaylee Rose is leaving to start up her own business. Whilst Kaylee has made it clear she loves her job teaching here at Banwell she has always been keen to pursue a career working specifically with children who have special educational needs. I would like to take this opportunity to thank each and every one of these people for their hard work and dedication to Banwell. We will miss them all!

Whilst it is always sad to be saying goodbye to our colleagues we are excited to be welcoming new teachers to the team in September. We have spent a lot of time going through robust recruitment procedures in term 5 and are delighted to tell you that we have now secured high quality teachers who will join us in September.

Mrs Julia Bevan will be our mixed YR and Y1 teacher and will also be the lower school phase leader. She comes to us as an experienced teacher and early years leader from another local school and we feel very









lucky to have secured her appointment with us. She brings a wealth of experience and expertise with her and I know she is really keen to develop our provision in reception, year 1 and year 2.

Miss Sarah Dockerty will become the mixed Y1 and Y2 teacher. Sarah wowed us at interview and comes from a school over the border in Somerset. She too is looking forward to working alongside Julia to enhance and develop our provision in the lower school.

Miss Thea Dennett will joining the key stage 2 team as our Y3 teacher. Thea is an Early Career Teacher (ECT) who has just finished her training and can't wait to get stuck into her first teaching post. She is really excited to be joining Banwell and I know she will bring lots of enthusiasm and ideas to the team.

Miss Rosie Nieters is an experienced practitioner who will take up the position of our Y4 teacher from September. Rosie currently works in Bristol and is looking forward to bringing her skills and expertise to our team.

I am delighted that Mr Nicolaides will be staying with us at Banwell for the next year and teaching Y5 for 3 days a week. Mr Davis will continue to teach Y5 for the remaining 2 days. Mrs Nicholson will stay as the Y6 teacher.

Support staff deployment for the new school year is also now being considered.
