We will develop understanding of the various aspects

of using a computer to create and manipulate text, becoming familiar with the keyboard and mouse and make choices about the changes that can be made,



Science

Materials and their properties.

We will be identifying and comparing different materials on the basis of their properties. and why

their properties make them useful for different jobs. We will find out how the shapes of solid objects made from some materials



can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching. We will investigate whether a material can float and how this is effected by it's shape.

Maths

We will be following the White Rose mastery maths planning and use Concrete (practical resources), Pictorial (drawing) and Abstract (numbers) approach to learning.

We will be using objects for children to add, subtract, multiply or divide. They then progress to using pictorial representations of the object, and when they are secure with this we then move to using symbols. We use number lines to help us count on and back from any number.
