The Code of Practice 2014 requires Local Authorities to provide a SENDIAS Service for parents, children and young people. Supportive Parents provides this service in Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire.

SENDIAS are statutory services providing information, advice and support to parents and carers, children and young people with special educational needs and disabilities. Supportive Parents helps parents, young people and professionals to work together.
