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Dear Parents/Carers,

Year 1 and Year 2 are planning an exciting 'wow' visit on <u>Tuesday 18th June</u> to visit Noah's Ark Zoo Farm and take part in our own African Safari. This is part of our new learning project of 'Wild about Africa - What would we see on a savannah safari?'

At Noah's Ark, the children will find out about the natural habitats, diet and other information about African animals. We will also be having a tractor ride so we get to experience what a jeep safari would be like.

To cover the cost of the trip, we need a £14.20 (£7.10 for Pupil Premium children) voluntary contribution. This covers the cost of the coach as well as the tractor ride. No spending money will be required on the day.

Although the cost of the trip is voluntary, in reality the trip will not be able to take place unless costs are met. We therefore ask that your contributions be paid and permission given on ParentPay by: Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June at the very latest.

On the day, your child will need to have a packed lunch, which the school kitchen can provide or you can provide your own if you prefer. When making your payment for the trip on Parentpay you will need to type in the notes box YES (for a school packed lunch) or NO (you will be providing your own). Please also provide your child with plenty to drink but nothing fizzy.

We will be leaving school at <u>9:00 am</u> and will return at the end of the school day. Full school uniform needs to be worn for the trip, along with sensible shoes as there will be some walking involved.
