We continue to have very successful camps at Knapp House Activity Centre in Bideford, Devon. It is always a brilliant experience for the children because they have opportunities to participate in physically and socially challenging activities, that are impossible to provide in our school environment. Knapp House is a family run activity centre set in its own grounds which boasts an indoor swimming pool. Most activities are on site but we also visit the nearby coast at Appledore and Westward Ho! All the activities encourage leadership and personal development and the children benefit by becoming more self-reliant, responsible and will have heightened self-esteem and confidence as a result of the trip. It also has the benefits of bonding the class at the start of a very important year and we do like all children to attend.

Daytime activities that the children take part in include surfing, paddle boats, climbing and abseiling, tree hoist, ringo rides, crabbing and RIB ride, tunnelling, low ropes course and pedal-karting.

Knapp House provides excellent instruction and a high level of personal and pastoral care. The party will also obviously be under the care of staff from Banwell School. The children will be kept busy with a full schedule of day time and evening activities. They are provided with 3 substantial meals a day and the cafeteria style dining allows a selection of hot, wholesome food. In this way the children can select the variety and quantity of food that they require.
