

Dear Parents & Carers,

I hope all of your families continue to be well at this unusual time we find ourselves in. I am writing to you all today to provide a number if updates as we head towards the end of term.

STAFFING UPDATES:

Firstly, as you are already aware, Mrs Lester is leaving us at the end of term to take up the post of Headteacher at Tickenham Primary School. I can now confirm that Mrs Philpott will also be leaving us at the end of August to begin an exciting new chapter in her life. In addition, we have two Learning Support Assistants leaving in the summer; Mrs Brien and Mrs Thyer. I am sure that you will all join me in thanking these people for everything they have done for Banwell over the years and wish them well for the future.

In agreement with the Governors, we are postponing recruitment of a new Deputy Headteacher and SENCO until January 2020 due to the current COVID-19 situation.

We have now appointed a teacher to replace Mrs Philpott. Mr Henry Lowe will be joining us in September 2020. Some of you may remember him as a student teacher last year, working in Year 2 alongside Mrs Philpott, so I am delighted that we have been able to secure him as a teacher at Banwell from September.

Mrs Parker and Mr Fuller have been successfully appointed as full time Learning Support Assistants (LSAs) to work with our children in Key Stage 2 in receipt of top up funding. Mrs Bradbury will also continue to work in this role. These LSAs will work closely with the Class Teachers, Teaching Assistants and Learning Mentor to support the children.

CLASS STRUCTURE SEPTEMBER 2020

I would like to share the new class structure for September with everyone. Where possible, in light of the disrupted year that the children have had due to COVID-19, I have tried to keep some continuity with the classes (eg, having a familiar adult move with them). Where this hasn't been possible it has been because I have wanted to keep a member of staff who is experienced in working with the age group with the class.

To enable this to happen for all children, the school term for the children currently in school (Year R, Year 1, Year 6, Key worker & Vulnerable children) will end on Wednesday 15th July. We will then invite each class in on a specific day and at a specific time for their picnic. Please see dates and times below:

Children will need to bring a picnic and drink from home. If your child is entitled to free school meals and you would like school to provide a packed lunch please let the office know by email as soon as possible and no later than 3pm on Thursday 9th July. Children do not need to wear school uniform on this day.

It is vital that timings are strictly adhered to please. This is to ensure we can manage the social distancing and only have one class in school at a time. Please could the children line up on the marked lines on the school drive (staff will be there to assist) ready to be let into school via the main gate at the specified time. We would ask that only one parents brings / picks up each child to minimise the number of people on the drive. If older children are allowed to walk home afterwards please let us know. All children will be asked to use hand sanitiser when they leave their parent at the school gate. The children will leave via the gravel path at the side of the Old Hall so please could parents wait on the grass when it is time for the children to leave. We would politely ask that everyone leaves the school site promptly so that the next group are able to arrive in line with our social distancing. Please could we ask that you let the school office know if your child will be attending the end of term picnic for their class so that we know who to expect.

We really hope that the weather will allow these events to take place. If the weather does not allow for the picnics to happen, we will hold a Zoom meeting for each class at the designated time instead. The office team will send an invite out for these meetings so that all parents have them, just in case.

I hope that everyone understands the importance of every child having the opportunity to return to school, albeit for a brief amount of time, before we finish the school year.
