We fully appreciate that it may be a challenge with the different timings between drop off and pick up times at Mendip Activity Centre and school especially if you have another child/children you need to bring. ### **The Children will need to bring:**

- A small rucksack (if needed for medication etc.)
- A packed lunch, including snacks, and plenty to drink. Children who are in receipt of free school meals will have a meal provided for them from the school kitchen but will still need to bring lots to drink.
- Appropriate clothing for outdoor activities. This includes a long sleeved top and bottoms (no shorts or t-shirts). - Sun cream applied prior to arrival. Hat / cap if needed
- ***Please ensure your child has their inhaler with them***

The trip will take place on **Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> October**. The cost of the trip will be **£12.80 (£6.40** for Pupil Premium children) which covers all the activities for the day. Please be aware that if we do not receive all payments for this trip, it cannot go ahead. Please pay and give permission via parentpay by Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> October.

We may need some volunteers so please let the office know if you are available on this date and would like to help.

Mendip Activity Centre has organised all activities ensuring the safety of everyone on site. All equipment will be wiped after use and hand gel is provided for use before and after activities. As a school, we will be following current government advice in relation to school trips.
