










Homework Grid Term 1 + 2

<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Compare the lengths of objects around the house. Choose some different objects. Measure them in m, cm or mm whichever you think is best for the object. What's the longest thing you could find? The shortest? What's the difference between? If you need to borrow ruler or meter stick just ask Mr Summers!</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English/Project</u></p>  <p>Write a story! The only rule is it has to be set in the USA. Could be in the Wild West, New York City, the NASA space centre or even Disney land!</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>PE</u></p>  <p>Outside, e.g. your garden, or in the park, find a route you could run (e.g. twice around the garden, once around the swings etc...) Ask an adult to time you. What is the fastest time you could do? Practice running and ask to be timed again. Compare your first and last attempt. Have you improved? Record your progress in your homework book</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Project</u></p>  <p>Have a go at making some classic American food. Maybe a pancake breakfast? Hotdogs, burger and fries for lunch? An apple or pumpkin pie for dessert? Or maybe something really different like a peanut butter and jelly(jam) sandwich or a corn dog? Remember to include your five senses.</p>
